

TOWN OF CLINTON HARBOR MANAGEMENT COMMISSION

March 10, 2016
Regular Meeting

Hayes called the meeting to order at 6:31p.m.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Bassett made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from January 14, 2016 and February 4, 2016 seconded by Adams. The motion was accepted and the minutes unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS

A visitor, Al Walker of Shellfish Commission asked to be given the floor to inform the commission of the Clinton Sailing Club (CSC). CSC is presently operating under the Clinton Placemakers. CSC will be a 501(c)3.

Walker and Alan Felgate have been working to develop the club. They purchased five used Club FJs to be delivered April 1st. They plan to launch from Town Beach. Gowrie Insurance requires certified instructors. CSC will be open to residents of other towns. The target age is 8-18; most of those who have signed up are about 14 years old. Brochures are being printed. He will leave some with Wahl at the dock. Adams will send a pdf of the brochure to Cedar Island residents when it's available.

Commission encouraged Walker to keep them informed of progress.

There was a brief discussion about Indian River Shellfish.

MAINTENANCE DREDGING AND LAUNCH RAMP REPAIR

Gesick reported that RACE is moving ahead with a COP for the dredging project.

RACE will submit sediment plan to DEEP. Estimate 13-14000 cubic yards of material to be disposed. Will need to present the expense to the Board of Selectman.

DOCKMASTER REPORT

Wahl reports that ramp dock should be back in place next week.

Cedar Island docks should be usable for the 2016 season. Adams will go to Riverside to check and review whether they need any work done.

Salary budget will not be adequate for payroll to start the 2016 season.

HARBORMASTER REPORT
