

2016 04 12 Minutes Bike & Pedestrian Alliance of Clinton

Eliot House, Tuesday, April 12, 2016, 7:30 pm

Meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm by Debbie Lundgren.

Bike/ped signage was discussed. It was noted that the First Selectman will personally follow up with Pete Neff on what signage will go up this summer. BPAC will provide a priority list if needed.

It was noted that progress on a sidewalk extension to the new Morgan School was made at the town meeting last Wednesday, when a motion to allot \$28,000 for an engineering study passed by unanimous vote.

The Indian River footbridge project was then discussed. A letter of support has been requested from the Clinton Land Conservation Trust, and that letter should be received within the next week. BPAC will request a letter of support for the bridge from the Conservation Commission at their meeting on Wednesday evening, April 13. A date will then be set with the First Selectman for a final run-through of the presentation to be given to the Board of Selectmen. A letter has been mailed to Robert DeSista, with the New England Division of the Army Corps of Engineers, to determine whether ACOE authorization is required for the footbridge.

The Shoreline Greenway was briefly discussed. It was noted that the First Selectman is very interested in seeing the greenway extended through Clinton. We need to find a member who can move this project forward. The issue was tabled until the next meeting.

There was a brief discussion of changing our meeting night. Several prospective new members are unable to attend on Tuesday evenings. The subject was tabled until a future meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 pm.
