September 20, 2016

Chairwoman Catherine Zamecnik called the September 20, 2016 Administrative Session of the Clinton Conservation Commission to order at 7:10 P.M. in the Land Use Office. Members present: Chairwoman Catherine Zamecnik and Bertram Schmitz. Members absent: Charlene Best and Lawrence Ouellette.

Workshop: 30 Highland Drive: presentation to Board of Selectmen. The goal of the Commission is to have a conservation or some type of restrictive easement allowing for pedestrian and bicycle use along the edge of the property bordering the Hammonasset River. A letter will be sent to the Board of Selectmen. If need be, members will attend a future Board of Selectmen meeting to discuss this goal.

Workshop: Capital Expenditure: FY17/18. Goal: to keep the existing fund in tact until a segregated and protected account can be set up for the purchase and/or maintenance of open space. Zamecnik and Schmitz will represent the Commission at the Capital Expenditure Committee meeting on October 6, 2016.

Workshop: Open Space Inventory & Index. The second draft of the "Municipal Base Map" was reviewed. Additions were suggested. Schmitz will contact CACIWC for clarification of the items that should be noted on the plan.

There being no further business, Zamecnik **adjourned** the meeting at 8:45 P.M.
