Hayes called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Sullivan made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from March 9, 2017, seconded by Adams. The motion was accepted and the minutes approved.

DREDGING AND LAUNCH REPAIR

Sullivan reported that he reconciled the RACE invoices with the original proposal. There are no outstanding invoices. There are a couple of tasks in the proposal that have not yet been completed. One is the disposal permit from the Army Corp of Engineers. The other is whether a Coastal Site Plan will be required for upland disposal.

Hayes reported that he had a discussion with Jeff Shapiro of Cedar Island Marina about the possibility of upland disposal on his property. Shapiro rejected the suggestion.

The town has applied for a grant through the Port Authority for the dredging and launch ramp project.

There is a meeting scheduled for April 19 at 7pm to present the bonding package to the public. Hayes will attend.

DOCKMASTER REPORT

Some of the summer staff will start this weekend. Wahl will still need to hire a couple of more staff. Ice eaters and bubblers will be removed. Water was turned on this week. DPW cleaned the parking lot of sand and debris.

Snack bar will open mid or late May.

The launch ramp was discussed concerning any maintenance that may be needed for this season. Wahl will discuss with Neff at DPW to see if it's possible to redistribute or add gravel to fill in gaps on the ramp.

Cedar Island docks have been repaired and installed.

Town approved pump out boat.
