

BOARD OF FINANCE
SPECIAL MEETING
TOWN HALL ROSE ROOM
MAY 16, 2018
MINUTES

Present: J. Olsen, J. Scully Welch, L. Santos, M. Smith, D. Traynor, K. Carr D. Onofrio, L. Santos and O. NejdI

Olsen called the special meeting to order at 7:35 pm immediately following the public hearing in the Auditorium of the Town Hall.

Traynor made a motion, seconded by NejdI to accept the proposal from the Library Board of Trustees to reduce their budget from \$7,500 to \$10,000. The motion passed with a vote of 4 in favor (Traynor, NejdI, Smith and Onofrio) and 2 opposed (Scully Welch and Olsen).

Traynor made a motion, seconded Scully Welch to restore the funding for the pump out boat for a total of \$7,000. After some discussion Traynor made a motion, seconded by Scully Welch to cut off the debate and call the motion to a vote. The motion was unanimously approved. The motion to restore the funding for the pump out boat passed with a vote of 5 in favor (Scully Welch, Traynor, NejdI, Onofrio, Smith) and 1 opposed (Olsen).

Traynor made a motion, seconded by Onofrio to approve a total town budget of \$18,185,249 and send to referendum on May 23, 2018. The motion was approved with a vote of 4 in favor (Traynor, Scully Welch, Smith and Onofrio) and 1 abstention from NejdI.

Traynor made a motion, seconded by Onofrio to approve reduce the Board of Education budget by \$179,267 for a total education budget of \$35,674,055 and send to referendum on May 23, 2018. The motion was approved with a vote of 4 in favor (Traynor, Scully Welch, Smith and Onofrio) and 1 abstention from NejdI.

Traynor made a motion, seconded by Onofrio and unanimously adjourned the meeting at 7:50 PM.
