**Minutes**

**Members Present:** Carrie Allen, Hal Tzeuschler, Niko Clados, Moe Bean, Dave Lee, Nicki Dakis and Paul Egan in attendance. Carrie Allen called the meeting to order and chaired.

**Guest:** Dave Lee of Clinton Families Helping Families

**Safety Day** Dave Lee from Clinton Families Helping Families was again in attendance to update status on the upcoming Safety Day event at Clinton Crossing, so this item was again brought to the top of the agenda to allow for Dave's participation and early departure. Dave Lee reports that the location for BPAC tent has changed, now being on the right side when driving in, near the Fire Department's location. Safety Day is August 4 from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. Rain date is August 5<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are requested to come at 10:00 am to set up. Participant/demonstrating groups may include Amber Alerts, Clinton Fire Department, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard and State Police with seat belt simulator and possible K9 demonstration (confirmation pending on some of these). Clinton PD Chief has offered to provide traffic cones and portable Stop signs for bike safety rodeo. Paul is able to provide 6 – 8 bikes, mostly 20" wheel size for both boys and girls for the event. Bikes will be delivered to Clinton Police Department, who will then transport them to the event on their trailer. BPAC is seeking more volunteers to assist for the event. Families Helping Families is seeking to buy or get 30-40 helmets purchased or donated. FHF will post on their Facebook page a notice to bring outgrown bikes. A bike collection place followed by delivery to Paul Egan for repair and redistribution.

**Minutes Approved** Revised minutes from the June BPAC meeting were approved by those members in attendance for that meeting.

**Indian River Bridge** The foot bridge is finished! A ribbon cutting has been suggested to showcase the bridge, celebrate the successful completion of the project and recognize the efforts of Clinton Department of Public Works.

**Route 81 Corridor Study** There was a quick recap of what was discussed at the Corridor Study which took place last month at the new Morgan High School to inform those who were not in attendance. The overwhelming response of bike and pedestrian friendly ideas was encouraging.

**Clinton Greenway** Carrie reported that 30 Greenway signs have been ordered. Pete Neff was consulted on how many signs would be appropriate for the route. Niko demonstrated his map-sharing idea to provide for maps and help reduce/recycle paper and litter on the Greenway. Covered map boxes at each end of the trail was deemed sensible.

**BPAC FaceBook Page** Moe reports no negativity on any post. Many views on last post (Indian River Bridge) with numerous reactions, likes and comments. 463 followers.
