The Clinton Planning & Zoning Commission has submitted the referenced petition for review for intermunicipal impacts and impacts to the ecosystem of Long Island Sound pursuant to Section 8-3b of the Connecticut General Statutes. The zoning regulation section rearrangement is considered as "housekeeping" and includes no substantial changes. This review is being provided to Commission for their consideration at the public hearing scheduled to commence on Monday, October 3, 2016.
