Chairman C. Aniskovich called the workshop to order at 6:00 PM.

**FEDERAL AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING**

K. Kilduff updated the council on the ARPA funding requests from the last meeting.

- \$40,000 for Digital Budget Books were added to the request as a result of the discussions from an earlier Council meeting.
- Total funding request is currently at \$2,033,700 of which only \$1,742,260 is available. The council will need to reduce the funding by \$291,440.
- The council removed the digital budget books from the funding request.
- Robert Potter reviewed Park & Recreation's top 3 priority projects. The estimate for the bleachers came in at \$262,000. The town was awarded a \$55,000 grant to be used at the town beach. Potter informed the council that the plan is to have 1 pickle ball court at the beach in place of the bocce court. The cost for a study to be done to identify a possible location for Pickle ball courts is \$9,500.

The council will need to schedule another workshop to finalize the finding. Once there is a consensus on funding then the council will need to schedule a public hearing.

The workshop adjourned at 6:52 PM.
