Also present were Superintendent Maryann O'Donnell, Assistant Superintendent Marco Famiglietti, and Business Manager Charles Carey.

B. Pledge of Allegiance

2. 2026-27 Budget Discussion

M. O'Donnell shared that she is able to reduce the Superintendent's proposed operating budget increase of 5.62% to an increase of 5.44%, with reductions in the areas of tuition and professional services. The subcommittee reviewed and discussed related services staffing trends and enrollment patterns of special education students in various programs, which has been variable. C. Carey reviewed health insurance cost projections and based on the current census, the district's increase for next year is budgeted at 12%, which is the lower end of the CT State Partnership increase projections. M. O'Donnell has shared the current budget status with the Town Manager for planning purposes. The final budget proposal will be on the agenda for review and approval at the February 2 regular meeting.

3. General Discussion

The final budget proposal will be shared with the Board by the end of the week, and the Board will vote on the budget at the next regular meeting on Monday, February 2, 2026
