Higgins called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Jaffe made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from January 14, 2022, seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was accepted and the minutes approved.

CORRESPONDENCE

- Kaplan 34 Sols Point
A certificate of permission was issued by DEEP.

- 17 Kelsey Road
An unpermitted walkway was installed from the house to the dock. The owner has requested that DEEP approve the walkway after the fact. DEEP approves of the design of a raised walkway to allow for vegetation to grow. The Shellfish Commission is in favor of the project. DEEP is requesting that the Harbor Management Commission review the application and comment.

- Lease sites for oysters in Hammock River, the mouth of Indian River and Hammock Point. There was a long discussion about navigation. The oysters will be collected in bags as opposed to cages. Church, as Harbor Master will protect navigation.

Jaffe made a motion to support this aquaculture activity as long as it doesn't impede navigation; seconded by Dahlgren. Parker abstained. The motion was approved.

- Two mooring requests for 28' boats were submitted to the Harbor Master and then to HMC. Application forms were submitted to the Harbor Master and reviewed. Moorings will be engineered and maintained by Beebe Marine. There was a brief discussion.

Iverson made a motion to approve the moorings; seconded by Dahlgren. Parker abstained. The motion was approved.

KAYAK RACK

Higgins reported that the Lions Club has offered \$2000 to the Town to build a kayak rack for Esposito Beach. The Eagle Scout who had approached the commission last year will likely have aged out of Eagle Scouts. DPW is currently sourcing the materials.

TOWN MARINA 2022

There was a lengthy discussion about a slip holder who passed away but the family plans to use it this season.
