The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM.

PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Aniskovich opened the public hearing up to comments. The council heard comments from Heather Moore, Andrea Reu, Brian Manware, Karin Gosselink, Erica Gelven, Laura Colebank, Kelley Edwards and Chuck Hill.

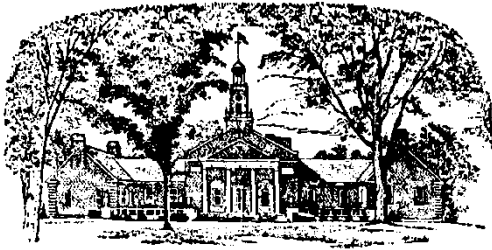
D. Donovan made a motion, seconded by T. Guerra and unanimously adjourned the public hearing at 6:21 PM.

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

C. Aniskovich called the special town meeting to order at 6:22 PM.

C. Walter made a motion to put the Public Works Truck Driver Position back into the town budget for \$90,000. C. Goupil amended the motion to reinstate the Assistant Public Works Director position within the budget. C. Walter seconded the amended motion. The Assistant Public Works Director position would add \$111,500 to the budget. After some discussion the motion was called to a vote. The motion failed to pass with a vote of 2 in favor (Goupil and Walter) and 4 opposed (Donovan, Richards, Bergman and Guerra). C. Walter made a motion, seconded by T. Guerra to add a Public Works Truck Driver position to the budget. The motion passed with a vote of 4 in favor (Walter, Guerra, Goupil and Donovan) and 2 opposed (Richards and Bergman).

K. Kilduff recommended reducing the State Retirement Contribution by \$10,000. The budget is currently at \$624,000. T. Guerra made a motion, seconded by D. Donovan to accept the reduction of \$10,000 from the State Retirement Contribution under Other General Government. The motion was unanimously approved.
