Regular Meeting

Adams called the meeting to order at 6:34 pm.

APPROVE MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Sullivan made a motion to accept the meeting minutes from March 14, 2019, seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was accepted and the minutes approved.

Commission wishes to thank Steve Hayes for his many years of serving as Chairman of the Harbor Management Commission.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

The election for Vice Chairman had been tabled at the last meeting. Sullivan made a motion to nominate Higgins as Vice Chairman seconded by Dahlgren. The motion was unanimously accepted and Higgins approved.

HARBOR MANAGEMENT PLAN

Discussion of plan and the ski area. Adams will see whether Indian River Shellfish pots will be removed for the summer. He will also discuss with Wayne Church, Harbor Master. Members will continue to review the plan.

DOCKMASTER REPORT

Markovics was not present but he had advised the commission that the marina officially opened on April 1<sup>st</sup>. The launch ramp was installed on April 5; Cedar Island docks are scheduled for install on April 15. Adams will address with Riverside and DPW to ensure that they are installed by April 1 in the future.

Markovics is working closely with DPW to get repairs made.

DPW will follow up with Pinder about the pilings that were due to be put in last year.

Markovics suggested ice be available to boaters. Will get quotes.

Adams will confirm with First Selectman's office whether Markovics is officially the Dock Master.
