Acting Chairman C. Walter called the workshop to order at 6:00 PM.

FEDERAL AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING

K. Kilduff updated the council on the ARPA funding requests to date.

- \$10,000 was allocated to study possible locations for Pickle Ball courts.
- The Child Care Support program is not moving forward so \$83,200 was transferred back into the funding for round 2.
- The Cyber Security Project is complete and \$3,162 was transferred back into the funding for round 2.
- Possible projects for funding in tranche 2 total \$1,818,622
- \$136,822 was allocated for Pickle Ball courts. Park & Recreation Commission recommended resurfacing the basketball courts at the Indian River Complex as a viable area for Pickle Ball.
- There was discussion on the Clinton Manor Gazebo Rehabilitation project. The estimate for the project is \$45,000. The council opted to not fund the project and leave the money unallocated at this time.
- The council agreed to move forward with the public hearing.

The workshop adjourned at 6:40 PM.
