Director's Reports April & May were reviewed and approved.

- Discussion about Youth Conference in Ohio; 6 youth, 3 adults attending; cost \$12,000
- Ian – still working on starting a MH support group
- ARPA money – contacted clinicians, extended number of sessions and continue to see clients. Funds need to be used by 12/31/2025.

Work is being done at the HS level; focus on microaggressions. Kathy meets with Marco. Discussed adult bullying and social media and how it plays into the youth issue. Survey was sent by Asst. Superintendent regarding the climate at CPS – how do we support our teachers. The Anxious Generation presentations had a low turnout – how to market these events to the community so more people attend.
