Town Council Public Hearing Meeting Minutes

The public hearing was called to order at 6:00 PM. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments on the proposed spending plan for the American Recovery Plan Act Recovery (ARPA) Funds.

K. Killduff reviewed the proposed spending package.

- IRRC Artificial Turf Replacement \$300,000
- Bathhouse at Town Beach \$300,000
- Bleachers at Peters \$262,000
- DPW Software \$43,300
- McCusker Landing Gazebo Roof Replacement \$15,000
- Road Paving \$300,000
- Replace Town Hall EV Charging Station \$6,500
- Public Safety Radio Project \$300,000
- Historic District Signage \$3,100
- Summer Lunch Program \$5,000
- Families Helping Families \$30,000
- Diaper Bank \$12,000
- First Church Indoor Air Quality \$21,000
- Gilead Community Rent Program \$18,900
- Morgan School Booster Club \$20,000
- Pickleball Courts \$146,000
- Total funds to be spent \$1,818,622. There is a balance of \$35,000 yet to be earmarked for anything.

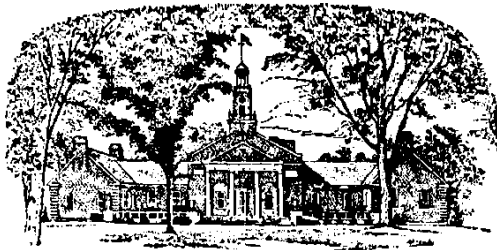
The meeting was then opened up to the public for comments.
