Chairman C. Aniskovich called the workshop to order at 6:00 PM.

**FEDERAL AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDING**

K. Kilduff provided an update on the available funds.

- The total available funds is \$1,818,622.
- Public Works software cost of \$43,300 has been removed
- A new request from the Clinton Arts Gallery for \$16,000 has been added.
- This leaves a total available funds of \$1,755,500.

K. Kilduff reviewed possible locations for pickle ball courts. The council agreed that the best possible location for the courts is at the Indian River Recreation Complex. The site location for the 3 courts would be on the far right hand side of the property past the baseball field along the river. There is a service road and sundial located in that area that would have to be moved. Inland Wetlands Commission would have to approve the location since it's in the wetlands buffer. The cost just to install the 3 courts without lighting or pedestrian accessibility is \$157,000. The council would also have to include additional funding for contingency. \$146,000 has been allocated plus an additional \$63,000 in contingency for a total project cost of \$209,000. The council agreed to move forward at the next regular meeting and set a date for the town meeting.

The workshop adjourned at 6:52 PM.
