**Meeting Minutes**

**Members Present:** Carrie Allen, Hal Tzeutschler, and Paul Egan in attendance. Carrie Allen called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and chaired.

**Update on Eagle Scout Project** Nic Coleback reported on the status of his Eagle Scout Project : the kiosk for Town Beach for the Clinton Greenway/Blueway Trail. Frame and roof are largely done, with the exception of shingles. Pouring of concrete footings scheduled for Sunday. After a few days to set, the two plexi-glass covered cases will be mounted on each side. The Greenway/Blueway map on one side, and perhaps upcoming community events in the other case on the back side. Carrie will work with a printer to enlarge the map to fit nicely in the case while maintaining aspect ratio of the map. Nic's design was based on the kiosk from the Madison kiosk on the Shoreline Greenway Trail (they were nice enough to provide plans for theirs). Nic's design does incorporate wise changes based on it's beach installation location (Madison's being more inland and higher elevation).

**Greenway** There is a need for a STOP sign on the east side of the trolley line segment at Grove Street. The curbing has been removed and pedestrian crossing stripes finished, but walkers and bikers need to know they don't have the right of way and heading up a slight incline and negotiating a right angle turn will put them significantly into traffic. Carrie has ordered a sign. Most of Grove and Commerce Streets have had signs installed.

**BPAC to host “First Saturday” Walk** Shoreline Greenway has asked Clinton BPAC to host the September 7 “First Saturday” Gathering/Walk. Each month they designate a meeting place and hike from there. They will probably ask again in the future. Those available should attend.

**BPAC funds** We have some money in the PayPal to pay for stone dust, etc. account and some in the checking account. There are still some donations being received from folks who weren't at the fund raiser event.
