Members Present: Carrie Allen, Mark Koschwitz, Hal Tzeuschler, and Paul Egan in attendance. Carrie Allen called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and chaired.

Minutes Approved Minutes were reviewed from August meeting. Paul made motion to approve, seconded by Carrie. Minutes from August were approved.

Update on Eagle Scout Project The kiosk for Town Beach for the Clinton Greenway/Blueway Trail has been installed. The Greenway/Blueway map on one side, and photographs of installation and community events in the other case on the back side.

Greenway The STOP sign for the east side of the trolley line segment at Grove Street has been ordered. Most of the Greenway signs needed for Grove and Commerce Streets have been installed.

BPAC hosted “First Saturday” Walk Shoreline Greenway “First Saturday” Gathering/Walk was September 7. From Clinton Town Beach, with newly installed kiosk, the walk proceeded on Waterside to Town Hall and the Eliot Preserve Land Trust parcel behind Town Hall. The walk was well attended and well received. One letter from a “walk attendee” from Branford was sent to the Harbor News expressing surprise at the beauty of Clinton and its shoreline which was very good press for the Clinton Greenway/Blueway Trail.

Outside event ideas There was discussion of have some events to highlight the Greenway Trail and encourage youth to spend time outside. These included a Paddle, Pedal and Plod kid's triathlon, a spring bike swap & safety check, and an organized ride on the “Bike Route” loop for which the Clinton DPW have already installed road signs on. Discussion followed on limiting the size of events, whether there should be age ranges or restrictions, etc.

Next Meeting in October will be last this calendar year

We will have our next meeting as normally scheduled but skip meetings in November and December due to holidays and scheduling issues and the decreased seasonal priorities of our BPAC work to follow up on.
