### **2. Review of Goodwin University Early College Advanced Manufacturing Program (ECAMP) Proposal**

M. Famiglietti provided the subcommittee with an overview of a proposed partnership with Goodwin University which would allow students enrolled in The Morgan School's engineering classes the opportunity to earn Goodwin University credits. Bob Werner shared information about the Clinton Manufacturing Coalition, which represents local advanced manufacturers, the town's Economic Development Commission, Clinton Board of Education, and Clinton PTA. M. Famiglietti shared a proposed syllabus from Goodwin University that would be used at The Morgan School for future engineering classes that would align the school's pathway with that of Goodwin University. Larry Chapman spoke of his experience with Goodwin University's professional development and the proposed sequence of courses to be offered at The Morgan School. The subcommittee asked clarifying questions and expressed support for the proposal. The next step will be to present the proposal to the full Board of Education at their next full meeting.
