

Town Council Update

January 5, 2024

The Clinton Town Council met on January 3, 2024 to start addressing the pending vacancy for the Town Manager position. After careful consideration, the council has unanimously decided to take an active role in the search for our next Town Manager and will function as the Search Committee for this endeavor.

The Town Council's search will be supported by Randi Frank Consulting LLC to facilitate a comprehensive and professional search process. Randi Frank Consulting is known for its proficiency in municipal management executive searches in Connecticut. Their experience will greatly contribute to identifying the candidate who aligns with the needs of our community.

The next step for the Council to ensure a smooth transition is to appoint an interim Town Manager to lead town affairs and collaborate with our current Town Manager, Karl Kilduff. This will maintain continuity and stability of our town's operations during the search process. The Council anticipates naming an interim Town Manager before the end of January.

The search process to appoint a new Town Manager can take four to six months.

The Council is committed to keeping the community informed throughout this period and identifying opportunities for public engagement.
