4. HOW TO APPEAL THE ABOVE DECISION: Appeals must be made to Connecticut Superior Court within two months of the date of mailing of this notice. (12-117a CGS)
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Motor vehicle assessments may be appealed to the Board of Assessment Appeals during the month of September (C.G.S. 12-110). Appointments are not necessary. The meeting date/s will be published in an area newspaper, posted to the Town's website [www.clintonct.org](http://www.clintonct.org) or you can call the Assessor's Office). The prescribed appeal form must be completed in order to appear before the Board of Assessment Appeals. (See Attached) Complete all sections of the Appeal Form as indicated. If someone else is representing you as your agent, a completed "Affidavit for Agent" is available in the Assessor's office. You will be notified by mail of the Board's decision. If not satisfied with the Board's decision, you may, within two months of that decision file an appeal with the Connecticut Superior Court (C.G.S. 12-12-117a) where it is highly recommended that you have legal counsel.
