PERMIT PROCEDURE

Gold, Precious Metals, Pawnbroker and Secondhand Dealer

Applicant:

Filing for a permit to buy and sell gold and precious metals with the Clinton Police Department in the Town of Clinton involves several steps. You are requested to do the following:

1. Complete the application (CPD-8.2) and return to police headquarters. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
2. A tax number must be obtained through the Connecticut Revenue Department. Include your tax number on the application form.
3. You must speak with the Zoning Enforcement Officer (669-6133) at the Andrews Memorial Town Hall at 54 East Main Street, who will issue a permit from their office (must have this prior to receiving your permit from the police department).
4. A background investigation will be done by the Clinton Police Department, which will take approximately 2-3 business days.

Upon completion of the application process, a permit will be issued. A fee of \$200 is due payable to the Clinton Police Department. The permit is valid for one year or any part of the year.
