SOLICITOR/VENDOR - PERMIT PROCEDURE

Dear Applicant:

Filing for a permit to sell food and/or products with the Clinton Police Department in the town of Clinton involves several steps. You are requested to do the following:

1. Complete the application (CPD-8) and return to police headquarters. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
2. A tax number must be obtained through the Connecticut Revenue Department. Include your tax number on the application form. (Selling of vegetables or fruits is exempt).
3. You must speak with the Zoning Enforcement Officer (669-6133) at the Andrews Memorial Town Hall at 54 East Main Street, who will issue a permit from their office (must have this prior to receiving your permit from the police department).
4. If food or drink is involved, you must have your vehicle inspected by the CT River Area Health District, 166 East Main Street, Unit #2, Old Saybrook (860-661-3300) and attach a copy of their approval to your application form.
5. A background investigation will be done by the Clinton Police Department, which will take approximately 2-3 business days.

Upon completion of the application process, a permit will be issued. A fee of \$200/ per person is due payable to the Clinton Police Department. The permit is valid for one year or any part of the year.
