CLINTON ANNOUNCES FALL PAVING SCHEDULE

Starting on September 21, 2020, the Town of Clinton will start paving on the following streets.

Liberty Place	Nod Hill
Colonial Court	Walnut Hill Road

Paving work will be performed by Tilcon Connecticut, who were the low bidder for the Town's paving program. Most roads will receive a surface overlay of pavement.

Preparatory work and milling will precede paving on Egypt Lane, Fairy Dell Road (between Brickyard Road and Long Hill Road), and Walnut Hill Road. Those road surfaces will have raised structures. Please use extra caution if you must travel on these roads.

Additionally, the following streets will receive crack sealing in October:

Elsie Lane	James Vincent Drive
Kristen Way	Ben Merill Road (new section)

Emergency access will be available at all times. Tilcon will direct traffic and assist area residents during construction. Driveway access will be limited during paving operations. However, no single driveway should be closed for more than an hour. On street parking will be suspended during paving operations. Minor traffic delays are likely.
